

We only ever use fabrics with special hygiene properties to guarantee maximum safety.

Our standard range includes a huge selection of fabrics that are extremely resistant to dirt and moisture. This includes functional fabrics that can be washed and are disinfectant-resistant like our easy-to-clean artificial leather, for example.

A special moisture protection membrane ensures evengreater hygiene by preventing moisture from penetrating the upholstery.

Many of our fabrics can be washed at up to 60°







Nicely concealed zips for quick removal

Our furniture comes with upholstery and covers that are easy to remove, meaning it can still be used as normal during the regular deep-clean process provided that moisture protection is in place.

Covers are removed and attached using a clip so that no additional tools are needed.





SPECIAL DESIGNS



If it is hard for dirt to adhere, less cleaning is required. We create furniture with as few grooves, crevices and notches as possible.

In addition details from invisibly attached components and upholstery elements to outer edges and optional hygiene covers make cleaning easier.





To avoid joints where dirt can gather, upholstered chairs can be designed to have integrated upholstery rather than separate seat upholstery. Upholstered shells are much more hygienic and easier to clean.

Cleaning and disinfection. Proper care, maintenance and hygiene information.

Proper cleaning and disinfection processes ensure that our premium furniture meets the highest of hygiene standards. Cleaning removes any visible dirt on the surface. Following that initial step with disinfection then reduces microbes by at least 84 to 99.9%.

Since every cleaning agent and disinfectant is different, we recommend referring to the manufacturer's instructions for use and always testing the suitability of the product on a concealed area first to avoid discolouration or abrasion.

As a general rule, disinfectant should be sprayed on and then wiped off. Be sure to use the correct amount of disinfectant and check that it is spread evenly over the surface. Using large amounts of disinfectant on isolated parts of the surface can cause permanent stains. Do not exceed a residence time of more than ten minutes.

Every different material needs to be cared for in a specific way, so be sure to read our separate cleaning and maintenance instructions.
